Straight River Update: Summary of two recent reports in the impact of irrigation on the Straight River, Jason Moeckel (DNR); Kevin Stroom (MPCA).

Rob Sip, Executive Director of the Red River Watershed Management Board provided an overview of flood management needs in the Red River Basin.

Scott Sparlin, Minnesota River Congress described the need for the creation of a water management board for the Minnesota River.

Robyn Dwight Keep in Clean Initiative described the need for funding for the initiative to keep trash off lakes in winter.

Jake Wildman: President-Minnesota Irrigators Association described irrigation issues and needs in Minnesota.

Jeff Forester: Minnesota Lakes and Rivers described the need for legislation focused on aquatic invasive species as well as regulations for boats.

Tannie Eshenaur (MDH) described the draft State Drinking Water Action Plan
